VISITOR/VOLUNTEER RULES

The following rules apply to all visitors or volunteers that may have contact with inmates incarcerated at the Boone County Jail. Failure to abide by the rules will result in termination of visits and volunteering privilege.

- All visitors 16 years of age and above are required to have a government issued ID. Children
 under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Altered or expired ID
 will not be accepted as positive identification.
- All visitors must arrive prior to the visitation period.
- Children must remain with their parent or guardian at all times.
- Visitors believed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed to visit.
- Visitors incarcerated in the Boone County Jail within the last 365 days are not allowed to visit.
- Visitors must be listed on the inmate's visitor log.
- Personal items should be locked inside your car or may be stored in the lockers in the lobby area. Those items include, but not limited to purses, bags, briefcases, and backpacks.
- Cell phones, computers, radios, cameras and other electronic devices are not allowed without prior approval from staff.
- Visitors may be subject to search.
- No provocative, see-through, revealing or inappropriate attire will be allowed.
- Touching, hugging, and kissing inmates is not allowed.
- Visitors are not allowed to give or receive anything from inmates without prior staff approval.
- Loud, rude, and obnoxious behavior will result in suspension of visitation privileges.
- No food or beverages are allowed without prior staff approval.
- Relatives of incarcerated inmates will not be allowed to volunteer.
- Volunteers are required to complete a Volunteer Form and subject to a criminal record check prior to entering the Jail.
- If an emergency arises visitors will be asked to leave the Jail.

I have read and understand the Visitor/Volunteer Rules. I further understand that a violation of any of the rules will cause me to lose my Visitor/Volunteer privilege.
